# Vincennes University Student Outcomes - CHE Wage and Workforce Measures \*

### **OVERVIEW**

This report contains reformatted information from the 2013 CHE (Indiana Commission for Higher Education) Wage and Workforce Summary Reports for Vincennes University. The report includes wage and employment information for graduates of Vincennes University (VU) from 2006 - 2013. The first worksheet provides data by degree level for all VU graduates (Indiana residents and non-residents). The second worksheet shows measures by both degree level and major for all graduates, regardless of residence. The third and fourth worksheets provide information in the same format for Indiana residents ONLY.

#### **METHODOLOGY**

- -Calculated wage, starting 2 quarters after graduation, for the next 4 quarters after that point.
- -Graduates with an annualized wage below \$13,195 are excluded. This \$13,195 figure is based on a part-time minimum wage at \$7.25/hour \* 35 hours/wk \* 52 weeks/year.
- -Wages are annualized after 2 quarters of wages in a year. If a graduate has only 1 or 2 quarters of wages in a year, they are not included in the employment counts.
- -Counts are unduplicated for each school year. If a student earned more than one degree in a given school year, the student is counted at the highest degree level. If a student earned more than one degree at the same degree level in more than one degree CIP, the student is counted once in the school year at the highest CIP code. If a student appears in more than one school year, the student is counted once in each school year.
- -A student is counted in only one post-graduate outcome per school year (employed or enrolled in additional post-secondary education). Employment at the above parameters takes precedence over post-graduate enrollment. For a student to be counted in enrollment, in addition to not being counted as employed, they must be degree-seeking AND must be enrolled in the following school year directly after graduation.
- \* Indicates primary suppression (values greater than 0 and less than 5). Wage is suppressed in a cell only if the "Total Graduates" is suppressed for the same year/degree level/CIP cell.
- \*\* Indicates secondary suppression, where the value of the suppressed cells can be determined by calculations, using the non-suppressed cells.
