IMPORTANT INFORMATION if you need to withdraw from a summer session:

Federal regulations determine how we must handle recalculations of financial aid for students who are enrolled in multiple sessions and withdraw from later sessions.

What this means for you!

- If you are enrolled in an intersession course and are enrolled in a 1st or 2nd 5-week session and need to withdraw from the 5-week course, **withdraw BEFORE the intersession course is over**, that is, **before May 25**.
- If you are enrolled in both 5-week summer sessions and need to withdraw from the 2nd 5-week session, **withdraw BEFORE the 1st summer session is over**, that is, **before July 11**.

If the earlier session ends before you withdraw from the later session, you will likely owe the university a lot more money because we would have to send more of your financial aid back to the U.S. Department of Education. This can have a negative result for future registration and finishing your degree or certificate.
